  - (3) If employer is more than one individual name and address of all Individuals concerned should be given in item 6 & 7 separately.
  - (4) Establishments in public sector means an establishments Owned or managed by
    - (I) The Governments or a department of the Government.
    - (II) A Government compcietyany as defined in section 617 of the Companies Act.1956 ( I of 1956)
    - (III) A Corporation (including Co-operative Society) establishes- ed by or under a central-provincial or state Act, which is Owned controlled or managed by the government.
    - (IV) A local Authority.
    - (V) “Establishment in Private Sector” means an establishment which is not an establishment in Public Sector.
